

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing in regards to Eucrisa for use of atopic dermatitis. Please consider coverage of Eucrisa first line for the Medicaid population. Eucrisa has been effective for children in my practice who have atopic dermatitis of the face, where topical corticosteroids are not indicated. Eucrisa does not have a black box warning for possible skin malignancies and lymphoma like Elidel does. The use of topical corticosteroids comes with side effects of hypopigmentation and thinning of skin and Eucrisa does not. Eucrisa has been shown to be a safe and effective treatment for atopic dermatitis in my experience.
