

Items that were not approved as a prescription drugs by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) under Section 505 or 507 of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, and therefore, do not meet the definition of covered outpatient drugs as defined in Section 1927(k)(2) of the Social Security Act, can not be covered by Medicaid Programs.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services' (CMS) has a continuing effort to remove non-drug items from the Medicaid Drug Rebate (MDR) system, which results in the items being noncovered by Medicaid programs.

The following items have been identified as non-drug items and are therefore no longer covered by Iowa Medicaid as outpatient drugs.
