#### Summary

**Indications and Usage:** Cleansing of the colon in preparation for colonoscopy in adults

**Dosage Forms:** Tablets (gluten free): Sodium phosphate monobasic monohydrate 1.102gm/Sodium phosphate dibasic anhydrous 0.398gm [sodium phosphate 1.5gm/tablet]

**Recommended Dosage:** 4 tablets by mouth every 15 minutes for 5 doses the evening before colonoscopy; 4 tablets every 15 minutes for 3 doses 3-5 hours prior to colonoscopy (total of 32 tablets prior to colonoscopy)

**Common Adverse Drug Reactions:** Hypotension, dizziness, headache, electrolyte disturbances, nausea, abdominal bloating/pain, acute renal failure

**Contraindications:** Known hypersensitivity to sodium phosphate salts or any other component of the product, congestive heart failure, hyperparathyroidism, ascites, acute colitis, bowel obstruction or perforation, ileus, pseudo-obstruction, severe chronic constipation, unstable angina

**Manufacturer:** Salix Pharmaceuticals, Ltd.

**Analysis:** OsmoPrep™ offers an alternative to the four liter liquid polyethylene glycol drink or over-the-counter sodium phosphate drink the evening before a colonoscopy. Other colonoscopy preparation products appear on the PDL with preferred status that are more cost effective than OsmoPrep™.
